Review of Minutes/Approval – Jenn Webb – approved Follow up on data reports

Todd said any parent is always welcome to visit. Ramos, C. Smith, Thomson were the classrooms that were visited. Brown said that we have really good teachers. This learning walk was about instructional strategies. Todd wants it to be nonthreatening and positive.

Zundel said that would be amazing! Woodrum: is there someone here or at the district that can give up some options of what the school can support. Good information that could be used

for the upcoming grant. We want items that will last longer than a year. Todd will follow up with Zundel and Ochs to see what the issues are with the computer. Didn't realize so many weren't working. Woodrum would like a follow up report next meeting.

Discussion/Community Input-

• Gibby – Parents have kids in the Spanish immersion program and that the kids really regress from 6th to 7th grade. They aren't ready for the high school program. Teachers aren't focusing on what the kids need. Is there an actually written curriculum for 7th – 9th grade? Parents are saying their kids aren't advancing in our program. It is hard when they come from elementary and spending ½ day and going to one class every other day. They are also now getting high school credit for the 7th and 8th grade. Brown: Any opportunity for an afterschool program to help with the social and immersion? Need to look at some vertical alignment between Harvest and VHMS.
