SCC Minutes October 8, 2018

Jenn mentioned moving it to January so that it doesn't conflict with end of term and Christmas concerts. Karen will ask about moving the parent meeting to January.

Todd talked about the book "Sold" – Our 9th grade English classes were reading it. It wasn't class assigned but was an option kids could choose to read. There were a few concerns, so Todd is asking any SCC members who want to read the book and then review it, to please do so. We will discuss at our next meeting, and determine whether to go forward or not.

Audrey introduced herself and explained what DCC is and her role to help bring issues to the district council from us.

Tom mentioned that 7th grade CCR's start in a few weeks. Counselors went into classrooms and introduced themselves and asked let the students know they are there to help!
